ARPA Needs Assessment Committee Special Meeting Minutes Friday, March 31, 2023 @ 3:30 pm Kent Town Hall with virtual attendance option

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 3:47 pm
- 2. The minutes from the July 6, 2022 meeting were approved on a motion made by Joe Agli and seconded by Barbara Herbst. Patricia Oris abstained from voting.
- 3. Public Comment: Elizabeth Place asked if information had been posted publicly about to whom and how much funding had been disbursed. The Commission answered that this information would be discussed during the meeting.
- 4. Barbara Herbst presented a summary of ARPA disbursements to the committee. Following the meeting a summary report will be sent by email to committee members and made part of the public record with names of individual recipients of ARPA funds redacted.

Barbara reported on First Selectman Jean Speck's and her own efforts to publicize – on line, through social media, and physical postings around town - the availability of ARPA funding and the application process beginning July 2022 immediately following the Board of Selectmen's endorsement of the Committee's recommendations. The application deadline was August 30th, 2022.

In the individual category of ARPA fund applications (\$100k pool), 15 applications were received, one did not qualify, 14 have been disbursed. Total amount disbursed was \$61,000. The \$39,000 remaining in this allocation of funding was then reallocated consistent with the Committee's recommendations. The entirety of that \$39,000 was used to fund non-profit applications, which exceeded the \$200,000 initially allocated to this group.

In the non-profit category 24 applications were received, 3 did not qualify. The total amount disbursed was \$248,816.24.

In the small business category (\$100k pool), 13 applications were received, one did not qualify, one is still in process. The amount disbursed is \$81,800 with an additional \$10,000 anticipated to be disbursed These are draft minutes. Corrections may be made by the Committee at a subsequent meeting. to the application still in process for a total of \$91,800 – leaving \$8,200 to be reallocated to the non-profit pool.

The remaining recommendations were for specific items of municipal infrastructure, municipal programs, and the Kent Volunteer Fire Department. Barbara has implemented a process of reimbursing expenditures for these items upon receipt that purchases and/or work has been completed. Thus, some ARPA funds for these categories remain undispersed while projects are planned and completed.

\$150,000 was allotted for infrastructure upgrades in Kent. The Sewer Commission has begun using their \$110,000 allocation for services required for a new roof for the sewer plant. The \$40,000 awarded to Kent Parks and Rec for improved drainage at Kent Commons Park and for the addition of outdoor exercise stations for adults has not yet been disbursed.

Some of the \$80,000 awarded to the KVFD has been disbursed – reimbursing expenses for a fitness room for volunteers, the purchase of a stair chair and AEDs. Funds for a two-way communication system have not yet been disbursed.

\$180,000 was awarded for various municipal programs. \$26,000 to the Board of Education for a summer enrichment program has been disbursed. \$24,000 for hybrid meeting equipment in town hall has been disbursed. \$1,000 of the \$40,000 awarded to Kent Social Services for the development of a multi-year program of adult/senior activities has been disbursed. \$10,000 for chrome books for the Land Use office has not yet been disbursed. \$80,000 for the addition of a break room for DPW staff has not yet been disbursed.

- 5. The ARPA committee members decided they should remain convened until all ARPA funds have been disbursed, meeting periodically to receive updates on further disbursements and any other business required.
- 6. The meeting was adjourned at 4:45 pm
